## School Uniform Policy \& Guidelines

Students are expected to be professional, clean, neat, and dressed appropriately in an Arts Prep uniform at all times. The only exception is on Friday of each week. Fridays are designated jean days; students must pay $\$ 2$ to be out of uniform.

Guidelines:

- Skirts, shorts, and skorts must be at least two inches below fingertip length or longer when standing (leggings or tights do not substitute for length)
- Clothing must cover undergarments
- Pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts must be worn at the waist
- Shoes, shirts, and pants must be worn at all times
- Flip Flops, including athletic slides, shoes with wheels, and cleats should not be worn
- Colored hair is not allowed for the entire head of hair. Streaks are allowed.

Clothing/jewelry may not display alcohol, tobacco, vaping, or controlled substance advertisements. Clothing may not display vulgar writing or symbols that are sexual in nature or which illustrate violence. Also, while the displayed message may not be obscene or profane, the message conveyed may still be deemed inappropriate and Students will be asked not to wear the clothing/jewelry.

School administration will make judgment on the appropriateness of clothing and/or appearance and reserves the right to prohibit Students from wearing any articles of clothing or other items which lead to or result in the disruption of or interference with the school environment and Student safety.

In the event the administration determines a Student's dress is inappropriate, and in accordance with this policy, the administration will either require the Student to change or will inform the Student not to wear the garment to School again. Repeated violations of the Dress Code will result in the student not being allowed to dress out of uniform on Fridays and depending on the extent and manner of violations may be subject to further disciplinary action up to and including suspension or expulsion.

School uniforms must be purchased from the school, with the exception of shoes, which must be in adherence to the school policy and photograph on the uniform order form.
